



REALTOR® Code of Ethics

REALTOR® CODE OF ETHICS TRAINING IS MANDATORY

Every REALTOR® is required to complete the National Association of REALTORS® ("NAR") Code of Ethics ("COE") training at least once during every given period.

Please note:

- a) **Most, if not all, real estate schools offer the COE training online. You may also visit www.nabor.theceshop.com.**
- b) **Although limited space is available, you may want to consider attending a course at NABOR, which is free to members, by registering online at www.nabor.com.**

FREQUENTLY ASKED Q & A's

1. Who mandates the REALTOR® Code of Ethics ("COE") training requirement? – **NAR**
2. If my 14 hour CE course included 3 hours of Ethics & Business Practices, does it satisfy NAR's COE training requirement? – **Yes. Please email your certificate of completion to NABOR (Corie@NABOR.com or Michelle@NABOR.com).**
3. Are there other methods available to satisfy the COE requirement? – **Yes. Through other Boards/Associations or real estate schools.**
4. I completed my COE requirement outside of NABOR. Is NABOR automatically notified? – **No. Please email your certificate of completion to NABOR (Corie@NABOR.com or Michelle@NABOR.com).**

FREQUENTLY ASKED Q & A's

5. Does my 45 or 60 hour post licensing course satisfy the COE requirement? – **No.**
6. Does my GRI 101 course satisfy the COE requirement? – **Yes.**
7. I'm an **attorney** and a REALTOR® or I am an **appraiser** and a REALTOR®. Does the COE requirement still apply to me? – **Yes.**
8. I'm a **REALTOR®** with Emeritus status. Does the COE requirement still apply to me? – **No.**
9. What are NAR's given periods? –
 - **5th Period = Jan 1, 2017 - Dec 31, 2018**
 - **6th Period = Jan 1, 2019 – Dec 31, 2020**
 - **7th Period = Jan 1, 2021 – Dec 31, 2022, and so on.**
10. As the broker of my firm, can I obtain a list of my agents who have not complied with the current COE requirement? – **Yes. You can obtain it by logging in to NABOR.com through the "Pay Online" button. Select "Broker Reports". Then with your mouse click anywhere inside the "Active Agents" box and select "Code of Ethics Status – Non Compliant."**
11. What happens if I do not satisfy the COE requirement on or before December 31, 2018? – **Failure to meet the requirement for the current period and subsequent periods will result in suspension of membership for the first two months, January and February, of the year following the end of any period until the requirement is met. On March 1st of that year, membership will be terminated if COE requirement has still not been satisfied.**
