REALTOR® Code of Ethics Training Information & Schedule

5th Period

(January 2017 - December 2018)

REALTORS® ONLY

Each REALTOR® is required to complete the National Association of REALTORS® ("NAR") Code of Ethics ("COE") Training at least once during every given period.

ALL REAL ESTATE LICENSEE'S

Real estate licensees who hold a real estate license that expires on **September 30, 2018**, or thereafter will be required to complete 14 hours of continuing education consisting of 3 hours of Core Law, 3 hours of Ethics and Business Practices and 8 hours of specialty education.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS & ANSWERS, Cont'd

4. **Does my real estate license renewal course satisfy this requirement?** – Please check with your course provider.
5. **I am an attorney and I am a REALTOR®. Does NAR's COE training requirement still apply to me?** – Yes.
6. **I am an appraiser and I am a REALTOR®. Does NAR's COE training requirement still apply to me?** – Yes.
7. **Are there other methods available to complete NAR's COE training?** – Yes. Through other Boards/Associations, home study, correspondence courses, or internet-based instruction that must meet the learning objectives and minimum criteria established by NAR from time to time. **Important:** If you choose this option, please see question and answer #8 below.
8. **If I complete my COE training at a venue outside of my primary Board/Association will my Board/Association automatically be notified?** - **No.** It is the responsibility of each individual REALTOR® to provide a Certificate of Completion to their primary Board/Association. Please email your certificate to michelle@nabor.com.
9. **As the broker of my firm, can I obtain a list of my agents who have not complied with the current COE training?** - Yes. Please contact Michelle McKenna at 239-597-1666 x230 or Michelle@NABOR.com.
10. **What happens if I don't comply with NAR's COE training?** - Failure to meet the requirement for the current period and subsequent periods will result in suspension of membership for the first two months (January and February) of the year following the end of any period or until the requirement is met, whichever occurs sooner. On March 1 of that year, the membership of a member who is still suspended as of that date will be automatically terminated, including MLS privileges.
